W - 2 Way - QRP CW WPX - as above, but both stations have to be using QRP.

## THE ZAGREB DIGITAL AWARD

Contacts must be made on or after 5 July 1992. You may use HF (including WARC bands), VHF and UHF. All digital modes are valid including: RTTY, PSK31, PSK63, THROB, HELL, MFSK, MT63, WSJT, STREAM, PACTOR, OLIVIA, etc. as permitted by the IARU band plan. SWL OK.

Requirements:

9A stations need 10 contacts.

All other Europeans need 5.

All others need 3.
