#### **ADRAD Jubilee Award**

Issued by the ADRAD (Radio Amateurs du Kaydall) to commemorate their 20th anniversary. Starting date is 1 Jan 1999. Earn 30 points, including at least 3 members and 1 special event station.

Special event stations are: LX20AK (10 pts), LX9AK, LX9DIG, LX9KS and LX0AK (all 5 pts.).

Other members count 2 points on HF and 4 on other bands. Any other LX stations count 1 point. All bands and modes. SWL OK.

### **European Community Award**

Work member countries of the EC on or after their date of membership for points. Each such station counts 1 point, and may be used only once. No more than 20% of the points may be obtained by contacts with one member country. A contact with LX0RL may replace a missing contact with any of the member countries. No repeater/satellite contacts. No band or mode restrictions.

Europeans must earn 100 points; each member country must be worked at least once and 5 LX stations must be contacted. No more than 10 stations from the applicant's own country may be used.

All others must earn 50 points; each member country must be worked at least once and 3 LX stations must be contacted. GCR accepted, though sponsor reserves the right to ask for cards. #### F.I.R.A.C Award

Contact members of this multi-country group of amateurs who are employed by their respective state railways. Groups are active in DL, F, G, HA, HB, I, LA, LX, LZ, OE, OH, OK/OM, ON, OZ, PA, SM, SP, YO, VE and YU. FIRAC members from other countries count for the MC group. SWL OK. Contacts since 1 Jan 1966. (VHF since 1 Sep 1975). All bands and modes, except cross band are permitted. Award classes are:

#### The Luxembourg Award

Awarded for contacting LX stations since 1 Jan 1951. SWL OK.

European stations earn 30 points of which 20% should be on 1.8, 3.5 or 7 Mhz.

Each contact is worth 1 point. All others need 20 points.

Contacts on 14, 18, 21, 24 and 28 Mhz = 1 point.

Each contact on 1.8, 3.5, 7 and 10 Mhz = 2 points.

If the same station has been worked on all HF bands, European stations may count 10 points and others 15 points for the required total.

The same station may be worked once on each band in different modes.

#### **LX-SOTA Award**

Contact LX amateurs and special event stations that are associated with scouting.

Europeans need 10 points, all others 7.

Scout chiefs and former chiefs are good for one point: LX1AT BG CC DB FB GG HA JH JX KM MK OM PC NK PC QA RF RQ RR SO TO LX2KO KW, . Scout club and special stations worked during "Jamboree on the Air" each 3rd weekend of October are good for 3 points each as follows: LX1JAA to LX1JAZ, LX1JBA to LX1JBZ. Scout special stations are worth 5 points as follows: LX75SL LX9LS LX0JBC. GCR list and fee of 5€, \$US5 or 10 IRCs to: Ray Mahr LX1MK, 21 rue de Moulin, L-3660 Kayl, Luxembourg.
